

Entry and Pricing Information

We appreciate you being part of our first Annual Mini Match for the Latin and Ballroom Club of Manual High School, a fundraiser sponsored by USA Dance, Chapter 2021 (Louisville, KY). The goal of this mini match is to give all interested students the chance to learn, dance, and compete in the multiple styles and levels of Ballroom, Latin, and other dances. We envision growing a community of amateur dancers in Louisville and allowing a larger audience in the area to experience the joy of dancing.

The purpose of this non-judged mini match is to give every participant the experience of a contest without the anxiety of competing against others. This event will help you prepare and practice essential elements of a typical dance competition, such as lining up on and exiting the dance floor properly, sharing and maneuvering the space together with other dancers, etc.

Once the competition has concluded, there will be a pizza dinner for all participants, followed by a USA Dance evening party for which the Youth Performing Art School will simulate the musical arrangements as they occur at larger competitions (e.g. Blackpool) by playing live rounds of all four main styles: International Ballroom, International Latin, American Rhythm, American Smooth, and a few other ones as well, such as Club Style and Country Style.

Full participant	\$125 per dancer/ under age 18: \$75
This is a person who plans on dancing with or without a partner during the day session. The price includes admission tickets to both daytime event and evening party, as well as a pizza party between the sessions. Each participant must have a valid USA Dance membership number. Show Performance	\$50 per dance
A solo (show) performance can be a single person to a couple to a formation team. Each dancer must be a USA Dance member to enter. The cost is \$50 per dance if you are not participating in the mini match. Mini match participants pay only \$25 for each show dance. If, for instance, there are 10 people in a formation and they are not participating in the mini match, the cost should be \$5 per person.
